#### **General award criteria:**

- Must be in Lower V (Grade 8).
- Only open to candidates that have applied, have been accepted to Roedeans School (SA) and who wrote the Academic Proficiency Assessment will be considered.
- This scholarship may be awarded at the discretion of the Senior School Head, acting in consultation with the Bursary & Scholarship Committee.
- The candidate will be selected according to the criteria for outstanding contributions in Academic as well as, Sporting achievement.
- The scholarship is partially funded and does not account for textbooks, uniforms, school activities and any extras whatsoever. The school reserves the right not to award the scholarship.
- The candidate and at least one parent should be South African citizens or have permanent residence. Roedeans School reserves the right to request proof of this.

#### **Further award criteria:**

1. The candidate should be of a provincial standard in at least one sport and proof of provincial colours should be submitted with the application. The candidate should play at least two other sports offered at Roedeans School (SA) at A-team standard.
2. **Applications close on 21 February 2025** and interviews will be conducted from **Monday, 24 February 2025** or on a day that is suitable for both the candidate and the Sports Department.
3. No award will be made if the level of skill and/or ability demonstrated is not high enough to justify it. The award is subject to the candidate maintaining a high standard of academic work, sporting achievement, and conduct.
4. The financial position of the parents is not a criterion.
5. The decisions of the Bursary & Scholarship Committee in awarding this scholarship will be final and no correspondence will be entered into.
6. The Senior Head of School will notify the recipients, telephonically, on **14 March 2025**, and all successful candidates will receive a letter informing them of the scholarship they have been awarded. No correspondence will be entered into regarding the results of the interviews. The scholarship will commence at the beginning of 2026.
7. In making an application, a detailed Grade 6 report will be required. In addition, any talent displayed by the candidate in the fields of music, dramatic arts, and/or visual arts should be mentioned. We reserve the right to request a letter of recommendation from the head of the school which the candidate currently attends.
8. Unsuccessful candidates are not under any obligation whatsoever required to attend Roedeans School (SA).

- This scholarship may be awarded at the discretion of the Senior School Head, acting in consultation with the Bursary & Scholarship Committee.
- The candidate will be selected according to the criteria of outstanding contributions, whether by way of meritorious sporting achievement or cultural achievement.
- The scholarship is partially funded and does not account for textbooks, uniforms, school activities and any extras whatsoever. The school reserves the right not to award the scholarship.
- The candidate and at least one parent should be South African citizens or have permanent residence. Roedeans School reserves the right to request proof of this.

#### **Additional award criteria:**

1. On receipt of an application form and a portfolio of evidence of cultural achievement, an interview will be scheduled at which the candidate will be required to demonstrate her skills in the discipline of choice, as detailed below.
2. **Applications close on 21 February 2025** and interviews will be conducted from **Monday, 24 February 2025** or on a date that is suitable for both the candidate and the relevant Head of Department.
3. No award will be made if the level of skill and/or ability demonstrated is not high enough to justify it. The award is subject to the candidate maintaining a high standard of academic work, cultural achievement, and conduct.
4. The financial position of the parents is not a criterion.
5. The decision of the Bursary & Scholarship Committee in awarding this scholarship will be final and no correspondence will be entered into in this regard.
6. The Senior Head of School will notify the recipient telephonically on **14 March 2025**, and all successful candidates will receive a letter informing them of the scholarship they have been awarded. No correspondence will be entered into regarding the results of the interviews. The Scholarship will commence at the beginning of the academic term in January 2026.
7. In making an application, a detailed Grade 6 report will be required. In addition, any other talent displayed by the candidate should be mentioned. Roedeans School (SA) reserves the right to request a letter of recommendation from the Head of the school which the candidate attends.
8. Unsuccessful candidates are not under any obligation whatsoever to attend Roedeans School (SA).
9. The discipline of expertise, i.e., visual arts, music, or dramatic arts must be taken as a subject to Matriculation level.

#### **Dramatic Arts:**

- An interview will be required focusing on the candidate's understanding of, interest, and experience in the field of the performing arts.
- The candidate must present a prepared monologue and poem (published works).



- They may be requested to perform an unprepared piece.
- Proof of any previous involvement in Dramatic Arts and related activities is required.
- The candidate will be required to study Dramatic Arts as a Matriculation subject and participate in school productions.

#### **Music:**

- The candidate must present a balanced programme of 2-3 pieces – minimum standard of playing must be comparable to Grade 5. The performance must not exceed 15 minutes.
- A theory paper, comparable to Grade 2 music, will be written.
- The candidate should have a musical curriculum vitae illustrating past participation.
- An interview will be required, focusing on the candidate's interest in Music.
- The candidate should have a musical curriculum vitae, illustrating past involvement in music.
- The candidate must have participated regularly, and for a sustained period, in at least one music group activity, and must continue such activity at Roedeans, e.g., by joining the choir, orchestra, etc.
- The candidate will be required to study Music as a Matriculation subject and participate in school musical events.

#### **Visual Arts:**

- The candidate's work must bear evidence of significant integration of Art into their daily life.
- Portfolio requirements:
  - A minimum of three most recent art works must be presented (not mounted or framed). Three different media must have been used: e.g.: charcoal, watercolour, and oil, or mixed media.
  - The works must be verified as the candidate's own original product.
- A short curriculum vitae is required describing the candidate's activities, spanning at least two years prior to date of application.
- Merits or certificates must be included on application.
- The candidate will be required to engage in:
  - A half-hour drawing session.
  - A fifteen-minute interview.
- The candidate will be required to study Visual Arts as a Matriculation subject.

#### **Conditions of continued support (annual review)**

- Behaviour — the candidate must conform to the Guiding Principles of Roedeans School (SA) as outlined in the Code of Conduct and make a positive contribution to the school community.
- To retain the Scholarship, the candidate will be assessed annually on academic performance, their skill and ability in their chosen discipline, and their level of commitment to the school.
